A Word from Pastor Charlie

What a beautiful name it is...

...and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. – Isaiah 9:6

Therefore God has highly exalted Him and given Him a name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. – Philippians 2:9-11

As Christmas approaches we celebrate the incarnation, the coming of God in human form to rescue fallen man. His name was to be called Immanuel, meaning "God with us".
