How would you graciously and winsomely answer their question?
- 3) If you were to name 5 of God's attributes that are most encouraging to you, which would you choose? Why?
- 4) What's something you learned from this month's reading?
- 5) Was there anything you disagreed with in the reading?
- 6) What questions do you have about the attributes of God? What questions do you think people in our church have about the attributes of God?
